Parish Council activities in the last few weeks have included progressing the pavilion driveway and village website refresh projects, running the village autumn litter pick activity and coordinating with SODC, confirming location of footpaths within the village, finalising the CPR Refresher Training Session, sorting maintenance activity on the recreation ground, arranging for the annual play area safety inspection, arranging for new car park sign installation and dealing with ad hoc queries.

Potholes, Paths and Gullies

With autumn weather now here then if you notice potholes on pavements/roads, blocked gullies, overgrown hedges in Moulsford you can either report it to the Parish Council or yourself at the website http://www.fixmystreet.com where you'll be able to see whether it has already been reported to be fixed. A number of items have already been reported by Parish Council for the village. If you have a smartphone then download the fixmystreet application and use it to take a photograph and provide a brief description to report the issue. The report will then automatically route direct to OCC Highways; this mechanism does work very effectively and OCC do follow up quite quickly with either their own or third party contractor staff despatched or with overgrown hedges, the landowner contacted directly.

Autumn Litter Pick - Thank You!

Big thank you to all those who turned out on a lovely sunny Sunday morning at the end of September for the Autumn litter pick! Many hands really did make light work and we were all done and dusted by noon with time for refreshments for all pickers! CPR Refresher Training Session - 24th November

Good news is that we have had enough people sign up for the CPR/Defibrillator refresher training such that South Central Ambulance Service (SCAS) will be running two sessions on the morning of Saturday 24th November. If you signed up then you will now have received an email confirming whether you're in the first or second session. We have a reserve list of attendees so if you want to be on this then please advise Parish Clerk.

Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator – Volunteer Opportunity

Although we've had one or two expressions of possible interest, this volunteer opportunity remains open. As highlighted in Moulsford News earlier this year, the duties are not onerous and mostly involve publicising messages via email from the police, or more rarely from people in the village, who have seen something untoward. If this opportunity is something that you might be interested in to help the village then please register your interest with the Parish Clerk.

Local Elections - May 2019

A reminder that the Parish Council is now into the fourth and final year of its term of office. In May 2019 there will be local elections and a new Parish Council will be formed as the current term of office completes. If you are thinking of putting something back into the village by standing to be a parish councillor and you want to know what is involved then come along to a Parish Council meeting or have a chat to one of the existing Councillors — there is usually at least one of us at one of the village social events and we're friendly to chat with! We quizzed SODC Democratic Services about what would happen in the event there were an insufficient number of Councillors (minimum is three) after an election and in that situation another election would have to be run — costing the village another £1500 (approximately). If after this second election there were still not enough Councillors then we would lose the Parish Council and control would pass to SODC. It has sometimes been the case that in such a situation, a neighbouring Parish has then subsumed the running of the "lost" Parish Council. Clearly we don't wish for these possible situations to happen as it is the people of this village best placed to represent our particular interests!

With us now into Autumn/Winter season of events, particular thanks to Moulsford Events Committee (MEC) for their efforts (all voluntary) in planning and scheduling these events for the benefit of all in the village so do come along and enjoy them – whether it be fish & chip quiz night or the festive dinner at the Beetle & Wedge! Similarly thanks also to the Pavilion Management Committee (PMC) for all their efforts in ensuring we have a pristine pavilion that is a great venue for so many of the MEC events! Particular thanks to both committees from the Parish Council on behalf of the village! – and indeed a general thank you to all those who volunteer their time and help the village in some way whether it be monitoring state of footpaths, helping with the monthly coffee mornings, monitoring play area equipment or delivering Moulsford News – all this support really is appreciated so a big thank you.

From the Vicar Andrew Petit

My dear friends,

11.11.1918 - 2018

The big event coming up in November is of course the centenary of the end of the First World War In Moulsford we shall be commemorating this with a special service at Moulsford Parish Church beginning at 10.45am so that we can join in with the rest of the nation in observing the 2 minutes silence at 11am – exactly 100 years from the moment the guns fell silent across Europe and beyond. Whatever your view might be on the necessity (or not) for that terrible conflict, no one can doubt the dedication and sacrifice made by millions of very courageous men and women across the UK and beyond, including a good number from our own community of Moulsford. On the tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Westminster Abbey are inscribed the famous words of Jesus: "Greater love hath no man than this: that he lay down his life for his friends." Millions did just that during the First World War. They were prepared to make that ultimate sacrifice partly because they believed passionately that only by such a costly commitment could peace be won, and partly because of the love they had for comrades in their own company or platoon.

Mercifully, it is highly unlikely that we shall be called upon to make such a sacrifice. However, our world today cannot be said to be at peace. This is certainly true as we look at the conflicts on the wider world stage, particularly in the Middle East, but even in our own nation, there is much division and conflict, whether it is political infighting over Brexit, or people being slapped down and even threatened in social media, or conflict in work-places, homes and families.

As we commemorate with great admiration those who gave their lives for the sake of peace 100 years ago, may we learn from their dedication and love and do everything we can to bring about reconciliation, peace, and mutual understanding and acceptance, wherever we find conflict in our daily lives. Sometimes being a bridge-builder can be costly, but it is as nothing compared to the price that so many were willing to pay 100 years ago.

Westminster Update





"Earlier this month Michael Gove announced a landmark Agriculture Bill to replace the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP). As we leave the European Union this Bill will replace the current rules. The changes announced will gradually transform the agriculture sector, giving farmers time to adapt. At the heart of the Bill is a commitment to tackling climate change. The Bill also contains a specific provision to enable government to provide financial assistance to improve productivity. This may have a significant effect on the farmers in the area, and I look forward to the changes in the bill being implemented.

Lidl have announced that they are planning to build a new store in Grove, to be built off Grove Road. A planning application for submitted to Vale of White Horse District Council on 7th September. I am pleased that we should soon being getting a greater choice of supermarkets, although the plans should consider the effect on local traffic. You can find out more details of the proposals at grove.lidl.co.uk.

The Bank of England is looking for secondary schools from Wantage and Didcot to take part in their digital media competition about the role of the Bank. The competition is aimed at students aged 11-18 and schools are invited to submit a short film on topics which change from year to year. This year's title is 'What will money be like in the future?' This month I was very pleased to visit Didcot Girls School, turn the first turf at Grove Business Park and visit EMS Physio, who produce specialist medical equipment in the Park. I also attended the commemoration of the centenary of WWI in Didcot, with the dedication of a centenary field.




